

FTA Committees

Adult Programs: The Adult Programs committee is responsible for planning, organizing, implementing, and facilitating adult oriented tennis programming. This can include anything from clinics to round-robin mixers.

Communications: The Communications committee oversees all general correspondence from the FTA. Primarily this is related to content on FTA bulletin boards at Timrod Park and Ebenezer Park, "Across the Net" - the FTA's quarterly newsletter, and the FTA website.

Development: The Development committee is chaired by the immediate past president and is continually looking for opportunities to grow tennis in the Florence area. These growth opportunities can range from tennis programming to tennis related construction.

Junior Development: The Junior Development committee organizes events and programming targeted specifically at area youth. The committee organizes camps at the Boys and Girls Club, puts on the Boys and Girls High School Invitational Tournaments, and organizes volunteers for other youth related events in the Florence area.

Membership: The Membership committee is charged with the recruitment of members to the FTA. The committee also maintains the FTA database and works with area businesses to procure discounts for FTA members. Members of this committee attend captains meetings and set up a recruiting booth at FTA sponsored tennis events.

Social: The Social committee plans puts on social gatherings. The FTA holds a membership meeting once a year as well as a social event which is opened to any tennis player as a marketing and recruiting event for the FTA.

Tournament: The Tournament committee's primary responsibility is the Wachovia Greater Florence Tennis Championship. This adult and junior tournament is held each October and is the primary fundraising event for the FTA. The committee organizes umpires, food, prizes, awards, and vendors for the event. The committee also provides assistance for other FTA sponsored events held in the Florence area.
